## Crocheted mittens

- free crochet pattern -


## Material:

- approx. 60 g yarn of your choice
- 3.5 mm crochet hook
- yarn needle
- scissors


## Step 1 - work in rows



Make a foundation chain of 10 chain stitches and work one Returning chain.

## Step 2 - Ribbing

R1: from the second chain stitch of your hook, work single crochets to the end of the row.
At the very end, make one returning chain and turn.
R2: from the second chain stitch of your hook, work back
loop only single crochet to end.
At the very end, create one returning stitch and turn.
R3-R29: like R2
R30: continue back loop single crochets to end (do not work the returning chain).

## Step 3 - main part

Connect both ends of the ribbing together.
To hide the seam, flip the ribbing to the wrong side (now it will be your right side). Work now in rounds.
R1: work single crochets to end. By doing that, you should create 31 chain stitches in total.
R2: *work 1 single crochet and 1 double crochet in same stitch, skip one stitch*, repeat from *to*.
R3-5: like R2
R6: create 7 chain stitches. Skip 7 stitches, insert the hook into the next stitch. ${ }^{*} 1$ single crochet and 1 double crochet in same stitch, skip one stitch*, repeat from *to*.
R7-20: **1 single crochet and 1 double crochet in same stitch, skip one stitch*, repeat from *to*.

## Step 4 - decrease

R21: skip 1 stitch, work 3 single crochets and 1 decrease for 6 times (24)
R22: work 2 single crochets and 1 decrease for 6 times (18)
R23: work 1 single crochet and 1 decrease for 6 times (12)
R24: work 6 decreases (6)
Finish off leaving tail to close the top by weaving the tail and pulling tight to close.

## Step 5 - Thumb in rounds

Attach the yarn.


R1: Work *1 single crochet and 1 double crochet in same stitch, skip one stitch*, repeat from *to* after you have 19 stitches in total.
R2-9: like R1
R10: skip one stitch, work 1 single crochet and 1 decrease for 6 times (12)
R11: work 6 decreases (6)
Finish off leaving tail to close the top by weaving the tail and pulling tight to close.

Use needle to weave in all ends.
And now you're done!

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
