MATERIAL

- some green yarn of your choice for 4 mm crochet hook
 - small amount of black yarn
 - 5 mm safety eyes
 - scissors and needle
 - stuffing material

BODY / HEAD

Round 1: 6 single crochets in magic ring (6)

Round 2: increase 6 times (12)

Round 3: single crochet 1, increase (18)

Round 4: single crochet 2, increase (24)

Round 5-8: single crochet around (24)

Round 9: single crochet 2, decrease (18)

Stuff firmly.

Round 10: single crochet 1, decrease (12)

Round 11: decrease 6 times (6)

Fasten off leaving long tail and sew the remaining stitches with the needle to close the hole.

Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

EYE

Round 1: 6 single crochets in magic ring (6)

Close the round with a slip stitch, fasten off and weave in end.

Insert safety eye in the ring.

Make a second eye.

ARM / LEG

Mark the position you want the arms and legs to be.

Insert the crochet hook here and chain 8 for the arms and 12 for the legs, working directly from the body.

Fasten off and cut the yarn.



FINISHING

Using black thread, embroider the mouth.

Weave in all ends.
