

The Elvis Scarf



Material:

- DALMATA by Lanecardate, 300 g in black
- 9 mm crochet hook
- scissors and sewing needle



Abbreviations:

R = row(s), ch = chain, st = stitch, sc = single crochet,
blo = back loop(s) only

Notes:

This scarf is crocheted in turned rows using single crochets in the back loops only (blo).
Add more rows if you want to make the scarf wider by using 50-100 g more yarn.

Scarf:

Chain 160.

R 1: sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc across (159)

R 2: ch 1, turn, sc in blo in 2nd st from hook, sc in blo across (159)

R 3-15: repeat R 2

Fasten off and weave in ends.

Fringe:

Cut some strands of yarn (number and length as desired) to create the fringe.

Fold your yarn pieces in half, insert your crochet hook through all stitches from first and last row and pull part of the yarn through. Put your hook through your yarn loop and grab the ends and pull them through. Untwist each strand of yarn to make the fringes fuller.

And now you're done!
