

## Emmy the Easter Bunny

- free crochet pattern -

### Material:

- Woolly Hugs FROTTEE XL, 50 g white, some turquoise and dark gray
- 5 mm crochet hook
- scissors and yarn needle
- stuffing material
- 9 mm safety eyes



### Body panel (make 2)

In white, chain 11

Row 1: single crochet into second chain from hook and in each chain across (10)

Row 2: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (10)

Rows 3-8: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (10)

Fasten off and weave yarn tails to the back.

### Ear 1

In white, chain 3

Row 1: single crochet into second chain from hook and in last chain (2)

Row 2: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (2)

Rows 3-10: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (2)

Leave long tail for sewing.

### Ear 2

In white, chain 3

Row 1: single crochet into second chain from hook and in last chain (2)

Row 2: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (2)

Rows 3-14: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (2)

Leave long tail for sewing.

### Arm (make 2)

In white, chain 3

Row 1: single crochet into second chain from hook and in last chain (2)

Row 2: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (2)

Rows 3-4: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (2)

Leave long tail for sewing.

### Leg (make 2)

In white, chain 3

Row 1: single crochet into second chain from hook and in last chain (2)

Row 2: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (2)

Rows 3-6: chain 1 and turn, single crochet across (2)

Leave long tail for sewing.

### Bow

In turquoise and leaving long tail, chain 3.

In the very first chain: \*1 half double crochet, chain 2, slip stitch\*, chain 2, repeat from \* to \* one more time. Finish off leaving long tail. Wrap the tail around the center of bow and make a knot with beginning tail. Leave both tails for tying.

**Pom Pom Tail:**

Wrap your white yarn around 2 fingers about 15-20 times. Cut the end of the yarn and, using a new small yarn piece, bunch the yarn together and tie it tight to secure it. Take your yarn off your fingers and cut all the loops. Then, trim to shape your pom pom.

**Finishing:**

Insert safety eyes into one panel between rows 5 and 6 with 4 stitches apart. Put your 2 panels with wrong sides facing each other and start crocheting around with single crochets. Do not forget to stuff before closing.

Weave in ends.

Fold ears, arms and legs to form a loop strap and sew them to the body as shown in the pictures. Leave 1 stitch gap in between ears and legs.

Weave in all ends.

With some dark gray yarn, embroider nose and mouth in center of face.

Sew the pom pom tail back to the body.

Tie bow to one of the ears.



And now you're done!
