

Uruguay Flag

- free crochet pattern -

Material:

- worsted weight yarn: blue, white and yellow
- 3.5 mm crochet hook
- scissors and needle
- stuffing material
- 6 mm safety eyes (2x)
- black embroidery floss
- glue



Panel 1 – Flag front

In white, ch 19

Row 1: sc into 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across (18)

Rows 2-3: in blue, sc across (18)

Rows 4-5: in white, sc across (18)

Rows 6-7: in blue, sc across (18)

Rows 8-9: in white, sc across (18)

Rows 10: in blue, sc into 8 sts, in white, sc across (18)

Rows 11: sc into 10 sts, in blue, sc across (18)

Rows 12-13: in white, sc across (18)

Rows 14: repeat row 10

Rows 15: repeat row 11

Rows 16-17: in white, sc across (18)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Panel 1 – Flag back

Crochet 17 rows with 18 stitches in one color only.

Sun

In yellow, 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Round 1: in each st 1 sc, ch2, slip stitch in the first chain, sc (12)

Join with slip stitch to first sc. Cut the yarn, fasten off and weave ends.

Assembly:

Insert safety eyes between rows 8 and 9, approx. 4 stitches apart. Put your 2 panels with wrong sides facing each other and start sewing or slip stitching around matching yarn color. Do not forget to stuff before closing. Weave in ends. With black embroidery create smile. Sew or glue sun as shown.

And now you're done!

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
