

Amigurumi bird

- free crochet pattern -

Material:

- some thick yarn of your choice
- 5 mm crochet hook
- scissors and sewing needle
- 10 mm safety eyes
- stuffing material



Step 1 - body

R1: 6 sc in magic ring (6 sts)

R2: inc around (12 sts)

R3: "sc 1, inc", rep 6 times (18 sts)

R4: "sc 2, inc", rep 6 times (24 sts)

R5: "sc 3, inc", rep 6 times (30 sts)

R6-17: sc 30

R18: "sc 3, dec", rep 6 times (24 sts)

R19: "sc 2, dec", rep 6 times (18 sts)

Place safety eyes between R14 and 15, 4 stitches apart. Start stuffing.

R20: "sc 1, dec", rep 6 times (12 sts)

R21: "dec", rep 6 times (6 sts)

Fasten off and weave in end.

Step 2 – Wings (make 2)

Magic ring, ch 3

R1: into magic ring 3 tr, 3 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 3 dc, 3 tr, 3 ch, slst into magic ring

Fasten off and weave all ends.



Step 3 - Beak

R1: ch 4, slst in 1st chain to form a ring.

R2: into ring 6 sc and join with slst.

Fasten off and weave all ends.

Step 4 - Finishing

Sew mouth to the body.

Sew wings to body and put some curly yarn on top.

And now you're done!
