

USA Rocket

- free crochet pattern -

Material:

- some cotton yarn of your choice, blue, white and red
- 2.5 mm crochet hook
- scissors and sewing needle
- stuffing material
- 9 mm safety eyes
- black embroidery floss



Body:

- R1: white yarn, 6 sc in magic ring (6)
R2: inc around (12)
R3: sc 1, inc, rep 6 times (18)
R4: 18 sc into back loops only (18)
R5: sc 2, inc, rep 6 times (24)
R6: sc 3, inc, rep 6 times (30)
R7-R11: sc 30 (30)
Insert safety eyes between R8 and R9 (5 stitches apart) and start stuffing.
R12: sc 3, dec, rep 6 times (24)
R13: sc 24 (24)
R14-R15: blue yarn, sc 24 (24)
R16: sc 2, dec, rep 6 times (18)
Continue stuffing.
R17: sc 4, dec, rep 3 times (15)
R18: sc 3, dec, rep 3 times (12)
R19: sc 2, dec, rep 3 times (9)
Fasten off and leave long tail.
Sew the remaining stitches with the needle to close the hole.

Finishing:

Sew wings (2x lateral, 1x on the back) and porthole to the body and embroider smile with black thread.

Turn the body upside down and with red yarn sc around in front loops only of R3.

Wings (make 3):

- R1: blue yarn, 4 sc in magic ring (4)
R2: 1 sc, inc, rep 2 times (6)
R3: 2 sc, inc, rep 2 times (8)
R4: 3 sc, inc, rep 2 times (10)
R5: sc 10
R6: 4 sc, inc, rep 2 times (12)
R7: sc 12 (12)
R8: 5 sc, inc, rep 2 times (14)
R9: sc 14 (14)
Fold the wing and close work with sc.
Fasten off and leave long tail for sewing.
Embroider with white yarn some crosses.

Porthole:

- R1: white yarn, 6 sc in magic ring (6)
R2: red yarn, inc around (12)
Fasten off and leave long tail for sewing.
