# Marvin the Moose

#### Material

- Woolly Hugs Charity, 50 g brown, 50 g black, 50 g white and 50 g red
- 4 mm crochet hook
- scissors and sewing needle
- stuffing material
- 9 mm safety eyes



#### **Abbreviations**

R = round (s), Rw = row (s), ch = chain, sc = single crochet, inc = increase, rep = repeat, dec = decrease

### Head/body (brown)

R 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)

R 2: inc, rep 6 times (12)

R 3: sc 1, inc, rep 6 times (18)

R 4: sc 2, inc, rep 6 times (24)

R 5: sc 3, inc, rep 6 times (30)

R 6: sc 4, inc, rep 6 times (36)

R 7: sc 5, inc, rep 6 times (42)

R 8-15: sc 42 (42)

Insert safety eyes between R 12 and R 13 with

8 stitches apart.

R 16: sc 5, dec, rep 6 times (36)

R 17: sc 4, dec, rep 6 times (30)

R 18: sc 3, dec, rep 6 times (24)

R 19: sc 2, dec, rep 6 times (18)

Stuff firmly.

R 20: sc 2, inc, rep 6 times (24)

R 21: sc 3, inc, rep 6 times (30)

R 22-26: sc 30 (30)

R 27: sc 3, dec, rep 6 times (24)

R 28: sc 2, dec, rep 6 times (18)

Stuff firmly.

R 29: sc 1, dec, rep 6 times (12)

R 30: dec, rep 6 times (6)

Sew the remaining stitches with the needle to

close the hole and weave in ends.

# Leg 2x (black/brown)

R 1: with black, 4 sc in magic ring (4)

R 2: inc, rep 4 times (8)

R 3: sc 1, inc, rep 4 times (12)

R 4: sc 12 (12)

R 5: with brown, sc 12 (12)

Stuff firmly (lower part only).

R 6: sc 1, dec, rep 4 times (8)

R 7-30: sc 8 (8)

Leave long tail for sewing.

# Arm 2x (brown)

R 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6)

R 2-10: sc 6 (6)

Don't stuff and leave

long tail for sewing.

# Ear 2x (brown)

R 1: 4 sc in magic ring (4)

R 2: sc, inc, rep 2 times (6)

R 3: inc, sc 2, rep 2 times (8)

R 4: sc, inc, rep 4 times (12)

R 5-7: sc 12 (12)

R 8: sc, dec, rep 4 times (8)

R 9: sc 2, dec, rep 2 times (6)

Leave long tail for sewing.

### Snout (white)

R 1: ch 5, in 2nd ch from hook

sc 3, 3 sc in same stitch, sc 2,

2 sc in same stitch as first sc

at beginning of round (10)

R 2: inc, sc 2, inc 3, sc 2, inc 2 (16)

R 3: sc 6, inc 2, rep 2 times (20)

Leave long tail for sewing.

With black yarn stitch on two nostrils.

### **Marvin the Moose**

Antlers part 1 - 2x (white)

R 1: 5 sc in magic ring (5)

R 2: inc, rep 5 times (10)

R 3: sc 10 (10)

R 4: sc 3, dec, rep 2 times (8)

R 5: sc 2, dec, rep 2 times (6)

R 6-7: sc 6 (6)

R 8: sc 4, dec (5)

R 9-10: sc 5 (5)

Don't stuff and leave long tail for sewing.

Antlers part 2 - 4x (white)

R 1: 5 sc in magic ring (5)

R 2: sc 3, inc 2 times (7)

R 3: sc 3, dec 2 times (5)

R 4: sc 5 (5)

Don't stuff and leave long tail for sewing.

### Sweater (red)

Ch 17, start in second chain from hook and work in rows.

Rw 1-23: half double crochet 16 in back loops only, ch 1, turn

Rw 24: half double crochet 16 in back loops only

Bring row 1 up matching row 24 and slip stitch across.

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### **Finishing**

Sew 2 antler pieces of part 2 onto the side of part 1.

Sew ears, antlers and snout to the head and legs and arms to the body as shown in the pictures. Now sew 2 antler pieces of part 2 onto the side of part 1. Sew antlers to the head as shown in the pictures.

Slide the sweater over the arms.
