

Pineapple Bath Shower Sponge

- free crochet pattern -

Material:

- 50 g Creative Bubble yarn by Rico Design
- some cotton yarn of your choice
- 4 mm crochet hook
- scissors and sewing needle
- stuffing material



This pineapple uses this puff stitch (ps):

Yarn over, insert hook in indicated stitch and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook), [yarn over, insert hook in same stitch and draw up a loop] 4 times (11 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through all loops on hook.

Pineapple body:

R1: using bubble yarn, 6 ps in magic ring (6 ps)

R2: inc around (12 ps)

R3: ps 1, inc, rep 6 times (18 ps)

R4-R9: ps 18

R10: ps 2, dec, rep 6 times (12 ps)

Leave long tail of yarn to continue working and start stuffing the pineapple with remaining bubble yarn.

R11: ps 1, dec, rep 6 times (6 ps)

Sew the remaining stitches with the needle to close the hole.

Pineapple stem – part 1:

R1: using cotton yarn, 6 sc in magic ring (6 sts)

R2: inc, rep 6 times (12 sts)

R3: sc 12 into blo (12 sts)

R4: sc 12 (12 sts)

R5-8: sc 12 (12 sts)

R9: sc 12 into blo (12 sts) - start stuffing.

R10: dec, rep 6 times (6 sts)

Sew the remaining stitches with the needle to close the hole.



Pineapple stem – part 2:

Into R3, in which you crocheted into back loop only (blo)

R1: sc 1, inc, rep 6 times (18 sts)

R2: sc 2, *ch 8, sc 3*, from * to * rep 5 times, sc 3, ch 8, sc 2, slp.

Fasten off and weave in end.

Start sewing the stem to the top of the pineapple.

And now you're done!



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
