Emilia the Elephant

Material:

- Woolly Hugs Charity, 50-100 g jade, 50 g rosé, some cyclam
- 4 mm crochet hook
- scissors and sewing needle
- stuffing material
- 9 mm safety eyes

Work body, arms, legs, ears and trunk in back loops only!



Trunk (jade) R 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6) R 2: sc 2, inc, rep 2 times (8) R 3: sc 3, inc, rep 2 times (10) R 4-7: sc 10 (10) R 8: sc 4, inc, rep 2 times (12) R 9-10: sc 12 (12) R 11: sc 5, inc, rep 2 times (14) R 12: sc 14 (14) Leave long tail for sewing.

Ears 2x (jade) R 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6) R 2: inc, rep 6 times (12) R 3: sc 1, inc, rep 6 times (18) R 4: sc 2, inc, rep 6 times (24) R 5: sc 3, inc, rep 6 times (30) R 22-26: sc 30 (30) R 27: sc 3, dec, rep 6 times (24) R 28: sc 2, dec, rep 6 times (18) Stuff firmly. R 29: sc 1, dec, rep 6 times (12) R 30: dec, rep 6 times (6) Sew the remaining stitches with the needle to close the hole and weave in ends.

Legs 2x (jade) R 1: 4 sc in magic ring (4) R 2: inc, rep 4 times (8) R 3: sc 1, inc, rep 4 times (12) R 4-5: sc 12 (12) Stuff firmly (lower part only). R 6: sc 1, dec, rep 4 times (8) R 7-30: sc 8 (8) Leave long tail for sewing.

Arms 2x (jade) R 1: 6 sc in magic ring (6) R 2-10: sc 6 (6) Don't stuff and leave long tail for sewing.

Flower (cyclam) chain 3 In the very first chain: 2 dc, 2 ch, 1 slp stitch, *2 ch, 2 dc, 2 ch, 1 slp stitch*, from * to * rep 3 more times. Leave long tail for sewing.

R 6: sc 4, inc, rep 6 times (36) R 7-10: sc 36 (36) R 11: sc 4, dec, rep 6 times (30) R 12: sc 3, dec, rep 6 times (24) Leave long tail for sewing.



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- free crochet pattern -

Sweater (rosé)

Chain 17 and work in rows. R 1-23: half double crochet 16 in back loops only, ch 1, turn R 24: half double crochet 16 in back loops only Bring row 1 up matching row 24 and slip stitch across. Fasten off and weave in ends.



Finishing

Sew legs, arms, ears, trunk and flower to the body as shown in the pictures. Weave in ends. For the tail, pull 3 pieces of yarn with your hook through a center stitch on the back of the body and make a braid. Finish off with a knot, and cut off the ends and trim.





For the hair, take one piece of yarn and fold in half, stitch your hook through a stitch at the top of the head and pull the loop through. Next, pull the ends through the loop and pull tight. Trim to desired length.



And now you're done!
