Amigurumi Pumpkin

- free crochet pattern -

Material:

- some cotton yarn of your choice in orange, green, white, black
- crochet hook in corresponding size
- scissors and yarn needle
- stuffing material
- 7 mm safety eyes

Pumpkin body: Chain 21, turn Row 1: half double crochets in back loops only, chain 1, turn (20) Rows 2-22: repeat row 1 (20) Row 23: half double crochets in back loops only (20)

Finishing:

Bring row 1 up matching row 23 to form a tube and slip stitch across. Finish off and leave a long tail.

Then sew through the loops along the top opening and pull to gather closed.

Insert safety eyes about halfway up the pumpkin.

Stuff the body and bring the tail to the bottom opening.

Sew the tail through the loops along the edge and pull to gather closed.

For the pumpkin shape, insert the needle through center of the top and down through to center of the bottom. Pull tightly to form an indent in the top and in the bottom.

Crochet two loop stitches with green yarn to create the leaves on the top of the pumpkin.

Embroider white yarn under the eyes and create the smile with black yarn.

And now you're done!
