

Onigiri Rice Ball

- free crochet pattern -

Material:

- white and black cotton yarn of your choice
- 2 mm crochet hook
- 6 mm safety eyes
- pink thread
- scissors and needle
- stuffing material and glue



Rice 2x:

- Round 1: with white yarn, 6 sc in magic ring (6)
 - Round 2: inc around (12)
 - Round 3: sc 1, inc, 6 times (18)
 - Round 4: sc 2, inc, 6 times (24)
 - Round 5: sc 3, inc, 6 times (30)
 - Round 6: sc 4, inc, 6 times (36)
- Fasten off and leave long tail from one side.

Nori (seaweed):

- With black yarn, chain 11.
 - Row 1: sc in second chain from hook and in next 9 chains, turn (10)
 - Row 2-14: chain 1, sc in each sc across, turn (10)
- Fasten off and weave in end.

Finishing:

- Insert safety eyes between round 3 and round 4 (4stitches apart).
- Use the long tail from one of the rice sides to sew around and don't forget to stuff.
- Embroider smile with pink thread.
- Wrap the nori around the bottom of your rice ball and glue in place.

And now you're done!
