Onigiri Rice Ball

- free crochet pattern -

Material:

- white and black cotton yarn of your choice
- 2 mm crochet hook
- 6 mm safety eyes
- pink thread
- scissors and needle
- stuffing material and glue

Rice 2x:

Round 1: with white yarn, 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Round 2: inc around (12)

Round 3: sc 1, inc, 6 times (18)

Round 4: sc 2, inc, 6 times (24)

Round 5: sc 3, inc, 6 times (30)

Round 6: sc 4, inc, 6 times (36)

Fasten off and leave long tail from one side.

Nori (seaweed):

With black yarn, chain 11.

Row 1: sc in second chain from hook and in next 9 chains, turn (10)

Row 2-14: chain 1, sc in each sc across, turn (10)

Fasten off and weave in end.

Finishing:

Insert safety eyes between round 3 and round 4 (4stitches apart).

Use the long tail from one of the rice sides to sew around and don't forget to stuff.

Embroider smile with pink thread.

Wrap the nori around the bottom of your rice ball and glue in place.

And now you're done!
