

SCAP mittens

- free crochet pattern -

Material:

- Woolly Hugs SCAP yarn
- 5.5 mm and 6.5 mm crochet hooks
- yarn needle
- scissors



Abbreviations

ch = chain, st(s) = stitch(es), hdc = half double crochet(s), sl st = slip stitch, hdc2tog = half double crochet two together

Notes

The pattern is written for size S.

Right and left cuffs are worked identically and with 5.5 mm hook. The main part of the mitten is worked in back loops only with 6.5 mm hook.

Chain 2 at beginning of each round doesn't count as a stitch.

Cuff, make 2

Make a foundation chain of 9 chain stitches.

Row 1: from the second ch st of your hook, work single crochets to the end of the row (8)

Rows 2-20: ch 1 and turn, work single crochets in the back loops only (8)

Connect both ends of the ribbing by slip stitching them together.

To hide the seam, flip the ribbing to the wrong side (now it will be your right side). Work now the main part in rounds.

Main part left / right mittens

Round 1: ch 2, work 20 hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join (20)

Rounds 2-4: ch 2, work hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join (20)

Main part left mitten

Round 5: ch2, hdc in each of next 2 st, skip 4 st, ch 4, hdc in each of next 14 st, sl st to join (20)

Round 6: ch 2, hdc in each st and ch, sl st to join (20)

Rounds 7-9: ch 2, work hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join (20)

Round 10: ch 2, *hdc in each of next 2 st, hdc2tog*, from * to * repeat 4x (15)

Rounds 11-12: ch 2, work hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join (15)

Round 16: ch 2, *hdc, hdc2tog*, from * to * repeat 4c (10)

Sew the remaining stitches with the needle to close the hole and weave in ends.

Main part right mitten

Round 5: ch2, hdc in each of next 14 st, skip 4 st, ch 4, hdc in each of next 2 st, sl st to join (20)

Round 6: ch 2, hdc in each st and ch, sl st to join (20)

Rounds 7-9: ch 2, work hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join (20)

Round 10: ch 2, *hdc in each of next 2 st, hdc2tog*, from * to * repeat 4x (15)

Rounds 11-12: ch 2, work hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join (15)

Round 16: ch 2, *hdc, hdc2tog*, from * to * repeat 4c (10)

Sew the remaining stitches with the needle to close the hole and weave in ends.

Thumb, make 2

Attach yarn at right corner and hdc where rounds 4 and 5 meet.

Round 1: ch 2, work 8 hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join (8)

Round 2-4: ch 2, work hdc around, sl st to first hdc to join (8)



Use needle to weave in all ends. And now you're done!
