Fwooper

by meeCrochet

Material

- Woolly Hugs FROTTEE XL à 50 g in fuchsia, raspberry, light gray, gold and apple
- 5 mm crochet hook
- scissors and sewing needle
- stitch marker
- stuffing material
- 12 mm safety eyes

Abbreviations

sc = single crochet, inc = increase, rep = repeat, dec = decrease, ch = chain

Body

Round 1: with fuchsia, 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Round 2: inc, rep 6 times (12)

Round 3: sc 1, inc, rep 6 times (18)

Round 4: sc 2, inc, rep 6 times (24)

Round 5: sc 3, inc, rep 6 times (30)

Round 6: sc 4, inc, rep 6 times (36)

Rounds 7-14: sc 36 (36)

Round 15: sc 4, dec, rep 6 times (30)

Round 16: sc 3, dec, rep 6 times (24)

Round 17: sc 2, dec, rep 6 times (18)

Stuff firmly.

Round 18: sc 1, dec, rep 6 times (12)

Round 19: dec, rep 6 times (6)

Sew the remaining stitches with the needle to close the hole and weave in ends.

Eye (2x)

Round 1: with light gray, 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Round 2: inc, rep 6 times (12)

Round 3: with raspberry, sc 1, inc, rep 6 times (18)

Slip stitch in next stitch and fasten off leaving a long sewing tail.

Insert the safety eye through the middle.

Wing (2x)

Round 1: with fuchsia, 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Round 2: inc, rep 6 times (12)

Without stuffing, fold the wing in half and sew closed. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Foot (2x)

Round 1: with gold, 6 sc in magic ring (6)

Rounds 2-3: sc 6 (6)

Without stuffing, fold the feet in half and sc (3) closed. Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.



Fwooper

- free crochet pattern -

Beak

With gold, ch 3.

Row 1: sc in second ch from hook, sc in last ch (2)

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Feather antenna (9x)

Take one piece of fuchsia yarn, insert your hook through a stitch at the back of the body and pull it through. Ch 6 and fasten off. Take one piece of apple yarn and pull through the last ch stitch. Knot 3 times and cut the yarn ends.

Feather tail (5x)

Take one piece of fuchsia yarn, insert your hook through a stitch at the back of the body and pull it through. Ch 11 and fasten off. Take one piece of apple yarn and pull through the last ch stitch. Knot 3 times and cut the yarn ends.

Finishing

Place eyes onto head between rounds 8 and 9, about 5 stitches apart and start sewing. Sew beak between the eyes.

Sew wings to the side of the body, around round 8.

Sew feet to the bottom of the body, around round 16 with 2 stitches apart.

Take one piece of fuchsia yarn and tie the feather tails together.

Weave in all ends.

And now you're done!
