## The Very Special Hexagon Cardigan

## Material:

- Woolly Hugs CHARITY, 200 g in white and 300 g in camel brown
- 5 mm crochet hook
- scissors and sewing needle
- stitch markers and tape measure (optional)


## Abbreviations:

$R=$ round, ch = chain, sl st = slip stitch, $s p=s p a c e$,
st(s) $=$ stitches, $\mathrm{dc}=$ double crochet


## Notes:

This cardigan is a $\mathrm{S} / \mathrm{M}$ size. The ch 3 counts as a double crochet stitch. You will crochet 22 rounds in total for each hexagon. For my cardi I crocheted one hexagon different like the other one. The color change is different and therefore the cardigan is a very special one. Add more rows of granny stitch to the bottom to make your cardigan in the length you like. Same for the sleeves: crochet more rounds of granny stitch for the desired length.

## Hexagon 1:

R 1: with color 1, magic ring, ch 3, 2 dc into magic ring, *ch 2, 3 dc into ring, repeat from * 4 more times, ch 2 and sl st to the beginning of ch 3 , fasten off and cut the yarn.

R 2: with color 2, into any ch 2 sp , ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 2,3 dc into same ch $2 \mathrm{sp}, * 3 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 2,3 dc into the next ch 2 sp , repeat from * 4 more times, sl st to the beginning of ch 3, fasten off and cut the yarn.

R 3: with color 1 , into any ch $2 \mathrm{sp}, \mathrm{ch} 3,2 \mathrm{dc}$, ch 2,3 dc into same ch $2 \mathrm{sp}, 3$ dc into the sp between 2 dc clusters (from previous round), *3 dc, ch 2,3 dc into next ch $2 \mathrm{sp}, 3$ dc into sp between 2 dc clusters, repeat from * 4 more times, sl st to the beginning of ch 3 , fasten off and cut the yarn.

R 4: with color 2 , into any ch 2 sp , ch 3,2 dc, ch 2,3 dc into same ch $2 \mathrm{sp}, 3$ dc into each sp between 2 dc clusters across, * 3 dc, ch 2,3 dc into the next ch $2 \mathrm{sp}, 3$ dc into each sp between 2 dc clusters across, repeat from ${ }^{*} 4$ more times, sl st to the beginning of ch 3 , fasten off and cut the yarn.

R 5: with color 1, repeat R 4 . R 6: with color 2, repeat R 4. $R$ 7: with color 1, repeat R 4 .
R 8: with color 2, repeat R 4.
$R$ 9: with color 1, repeat $R 4$.
R 10: with color 2 , repeat R 4 .
R 11: with color 1, repeat R 4.
R 12: with color 2, repeat R 4.
R 13: with color 1, repeat R 4.
R 14: with color 2, repeat R 4.
R 15: with color 1, repeat R 4.
R 16: with color 2, repeat R 4.
R 17: with color 1, repeat R 4.
R 18: with color 2, repeat R 4 .
R 19: with color 1, repeat R 4.
R 20: with color 2, repeat R 4.
R 21: with color 1, repeat R 4.
R 22: with color 2, repeat R 4 .

Fasten off and weave in ends.


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- free crochet pattern -

Hexagon 2:
For the second hexagon I used the same pattern as hexagon 1 but only with color change.

Seaming:
With the wrong sides facing each other, fold your hexagons in half (create an $L$ shape) and, using a slip stitch, seam the cardigan along shoulder as shown in the picture.


With color 1 or 2 , seam down the back of the cardi, leaving the front edge open.


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- free crochet pattern -

Bottom edge and collar:

With color 2, attach yarn into any ch 2 sp along body opening. R 1: ch $3,2 \mathrm{dc},{ }^{*} 3$ dc into the next ch 2 sp *, repeat from * to *. For the corners work 3 dc , ch $2,3 \mathrm{dc}$.
Finish round with sl st to the beginning of ch 3 .
R 2-4: repeat R 1.


Sleeves:
With color 2, attach yarn into any stitch.
R1: ch 3, crochet in every second stitch a dc and sl st to the beginning of ch 3 .


R 2: ch 3, crochet a front post dc with back post dc creating a ribbed effect, sl st to the beginning of ch3.
R 3-8: repeat R 2.

## Finishing:

Fasten off and weave in ends. Sewn on buttons if you like.

And now you're done!


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
